Apple Talk - New iPads for 2020

Apple has released a new range of iPad and iPad Air models for 2020, including new colours, storage capacity, screen size and price. The range is comprehensive so I will talk about the Air model only.

The new design has flat edges instead of the curved edges we have now. It has a bigger, better quality screen, 10.9in as opposed to 9.8in with the current iPad. The display is really good, colourful crisp and bright. It has a USB-C port for charging and connecting accessories such as card readers, and decent front and rear cameras. Colours available are Sky Blue, Green, Rose Gold, and the normal Silver and Space Grey. These iPads also support the new Apple Magic Keyboard and Apple Pencil.

The power button doubles as a fingerprint scanner. Still no face ID though. Storage sizes are now 64 or 256GB. 64GB as the standard size is double the storage of the current iPad. Earlier iPads had a standard capacity of 16GB.

Prices are - 64GB \$899.00 : 256GB \$1,129.00.

These prices are for Wi-Fi models only, Wi-Fi + Cellular models are at extra cost. Wi-Fi is the one most of us have, Wi-Fi + Cellular models have provision for a SIM card. For any more information please make an appointment to see one of our Tutors.
